Below is, I hope, a useful bibliography.

It was a very long time in the making. It began at a time when devolution was a dream, developed as Scotland got its own Parliament again, and has now been updated in the year of the referendum on Independence.

It was made for students in my Area Studies Scotland classes at Konstanz University. Students of English attended, as did students from any other department who had a keen interest in Scotland. In class they were well supplied with materials, from letters to travel brochures, from music CDs to maps, from recipes to supermarket flyers, from newspapers and magazines to oatcakes and shortbread, and even a visit from a real, live bagpipe player (thanks to the initiative of a student). With this bibliography I hoped to show them just how much relevant and useful material there is at hand in the well-stocked library of Konstanz University. Students of other subjects doing a Master's thesis on a Scottish topic have also found it useful. Of course there are more books on Scotland in the library than are listed here, but this is at least a starting point. And of course there are more good books on Scotland in print than are available in the library.

All the materials listed here are available in the **library**. Many of the books are on reserve so that you can simply go there and browse through them.

Some of the books provide a brief overview, while others offer a deeper insight into specific areas, look at developments and changes, analyse and interpret. Some of them can be judged to be out of date now. I have, however, left them on the list for students who wish to study change and make comparisons. For information on the current situation the library offers a Sunday newspaper and a quarterly journal.

For example, if you click on the Topic index you can choose a topic (e.g. Education and training, or People and society) and then get fact sheets, government publications, statistics, new laws etc.

www.talentscotland.com is the Scottish Executive's site for anyone wishing to work, study, visit, live in Scotland, with information on the cost of living, education, health care etc.

www.scottish.parliament.uk gives information on the work of the Scottish Parliament. There are reports on debates, information on the Bills which the Parliament is currently dealing with, help with organizing visits, and there is webcast coverage, which means you can watch it all live.

www.scotlandagainstracism.com is the Scottish Executive's anti-racism campaign.

www.bbc.co.uk/scotland/history has a tremendous amount of information on the past, including "Scotland on Film", "an insight into 20th century Scottish life and culture" by means of archive material from TV and film. This is fascinating. Among the miles of 20th century newsreel available there is an interview with the Scots farming couple who found Rudolf Hess, the German official who landed in their field during the 2nd World War.)
